

[25]Suspension of Public Transportation Services, Storm Warnings, Emergency Warning, Class/Examination Schedule Changes

I. Suspension of Public Transportation Services (for all reasons)

When public transportation services are suspended, a storm warning, or on emergency warning is issued, class and examination schedules will be changed according to the following criteria.

1. Class and/or examinations will be cancelled in any of the following cases.

*All classes and/or examinations will take place as usual in case of short-term temporary interruption due to accidents etc.

[Imadegawa Campus]

- a. When both Kyoto City Bus and Subway services are suspended in all sections at the same time
- b. When two or more of the following services are suspended at the same time (in all or part of the sections)
 - Between Kawaramachi Station and Umeda Station in Hankyu Line
 - Between Demachiyanaqi Station and Yodoyabashi Station in Keihan Line
 - Between Kyoto Station and Yamato-saidaiji Station in Kintetsu Line
 - Between Yamato-saidaiji Station and Namba Station in Kintetsu Line
 - Between Kobe Station and Maibara Station in JR Line

[Kyotanabe Campus]

- a. When both Kyoto City Bus and Subway services are suspended in all sections at the same time
- b. When two or more of the following services are suspended at the same time (in all or part of the sections)
 - Between Kawaramachi Station and Umeda Station in Hankyu Line
 - Between Demachiyanaqi Station and Yodoyabashi Station in Keihan Line
 - Between Kyoto Station and Yamato-saidaiji Station in Kintetsu Line
 - Between Yamato-saidaiji Station and Namba Station in Kintetsu Line
 - Between Kobe Station and Maibara Station in JR Line
 - Between Kizu Station and Kyobashi Station in JR Line
- c. When Kintetsu Railway (Kyoto—Yamato-saidaiji) Service is suspended in all sections

2. Time of service resumption and classed / examinations start time

Time of Resumption of Transportation Services	Classes and/or Examinations starts
Before 6:30 a.m.	From the 1st Period (No cancelations will be made.)
Between 6:31 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.	From the 3rd Period
Between 10:31 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.	From the 6th Period
After 3:30 p.m.	All classes are cancelled.

II. Storm Warning (heavy rain warning is excluded) and Emergency Warning

If the storm warning or any emergency warning is issued, classes and/or examinations will be handled as below:

*The issuance of an emergency warning for an area indicates a level of exceptional risk of a magnitude observed only once every few decades. Residents should pay attention to their surroundings and relevant information such as municipal evacuation advisories and orders, and should take all measures necessary to protect life.

When an emergency warning is issued while students are on campus, they should follow the directions provided by the University, or while students are on the way to the University, they should take all measures necessary to protect life.

1. Classes and/or examinations will be canceled in the event that a storm warning or any emergency warning is issued for any of the following areas.

*All classes and/or examinations will take place as usual in case of other warnings such as heavy rain or heavy snow.

2. Time of withdrawal of warning and classes/examinations start time

Time of Cancellation of Warning	Classes and/or Examinations starts
By 6:30 a.m.	From the 1st Period (No cancellations will be made.)
By 9:30 a.m.	From the 3rd Period
By 2:30 p.m.	From the 6th Period
Still under the Warning as of 2:31 p.m.	All classes are cancelled.

*Depending on the circumstances, other instructions may be given.

III. NOTE

If these measures were taken during the examination period, follow-up notifications regarding the affected examinations will be informed on the message boards.

When a Storm Warning or any Emergency Warning is issued, where necessary, the University will post an announcement on the Doshisha website, DUET, or message boards. Please make sure to check them during the alert.
